

How to enroll

International students will take the general entrance exam.

- The exam fee is 20,000 yen.
- If you wish to enroll, please see the "Flow of Enrollment" section of the information for international students on our school's homepage.

Other notes

- Those who wish to enroll in our school must have completed 12 years of school education corresponding to elementary school, junior high school, and high school in Japan. Also, please prepare a copy of the document proving your final educational background and a Japanese translation.
- It is the responsibility of each individual to update their residence status. Please request the issuance of the necessary documents well in advance of the deadline.

• You will be asked to provide a guarantor for enrollment and payment of tuition fees. We are looking for people who live in Japan and are able to earn an independent living, but if they are not in Japan, family members from their home country are also acceptable. In that case, you will be required to submit a copy of your family's ID.

*There are various other points to keep in mind, such as application qualifications and documents to be submitted, so please check our school's "International Student Recruitment Guidelines."
